About the Master's Program in Biblical Studies

The Master's program in Biblical Studies (MBSt) is offered by the Faculty of Protestant Theology in cooperation with the Centre for Religion and Society (ZERG), at the public University of Excellence in Bonn, Germany.

The MBSt program is the perfect choice for you if:

- you would like to immerse yourself in the centuries-long Continental European tradition of **exegetical work on biblical texts**
- you have already worked on biblical source texts in the original languages and have sufficient knowledge of **Hebrew and Greek**
- you have a Bachelor's degree (4 years) or Master's degree and **English proficiency** (B2/C1 level minimum)

As a research-oriented course, the one-year Master's program in Biblical Studies opens up the possibility of subsequent **doctoral studies** – at the University of Bonn or elsewhere.

What can you expect of the Master's program?



Duration

- The Master's program is a 12 months program
- At the end you will have achieved 60 ECTS



Structure

- Elective modules in the winter semester
- Compulsory modules and the Master Thesis in the summer semester



Costs

- The program is tuition free
- There is a semester fee of around 300 euros (incl. semester ticket for regional transport in NRW)

Good Reasons for the Master's Program

The University of Bonn has a tradition of more than 200 years and is one of the best in Germany. At the Faculty of Protestant Theology you will find support from academic experts and at the same time study independently.

Next to the **subject-related modules**, focusing on exegetical questions on texts of the Hebrew Bible and New Testament, you can choose an **interdisciplinary module** to deepen historical knowledge or explore contemporary topics.

Competences acquired in the Master's program go beyond biblical exegesis. You will also develop intercultural skills and the ability to participate in an international academic discourse.

Outside the university context, you will also have a variety of **job opportunities**. Intellectually trained and able to handle complex texts as well as argue different positions, you can work in international companies.
